#### WE ACCEPT

Latex house paint and primers  
Oil based house paint and primers  
Stains  
Sealers  
Clear finishes (e.g., varnish, shellac)

#### WE CANNOT ACCEPT

Leaking, unlabeled or empty containers  
Aerosol spray paints  
Containers larger than 5 gallons  
Paint thinner, spackle, glue  
Other hazardous waste or chemicals
